

Case Study - Executive Home Exposure

*How public records, images and family signals can create a bridge
between digital exposure and physical risk.*

Anonymized case study - prescriber use - 2026

Situation

This case is anonymized and recomposed to illustrate the Priveris operating model. It does not contain client-identifying details, raw OSINT sources or exploitable personal data.

A founder preparing a public transaction discovered that a residential address and family context could be correlated from public and semi-public sources. The concern was not one source, but the combination.

What made the case sensitive

Surface	Observed exposure	Operational risk
Home	Address linked to company and image sources.	Doxxing, pressure, unwanted contact or fraud credibility.
Family signals	Public photos and location hints correlate with routines.	Indirect targeting of close circle.
Accounts	Personal recovery channels still use exposed identifiers.	Account takeover and further intelligence gathering.

Timeline

Moment	Action	Output
J0	Cadrage du mandat, persons concerned and legal constraints.	Consent and perimeter documented.
J2	Exposure review across address, images, registries and family signals.	Risk matrix delivered without raw exploitable paths.
J7	Removal and correction requests launched where legally possible.	Easy public correlations reduced.
J30	Residual exposure reviewed and monitoring baseline created.	Family office receives non-intrusive status.

Remediation plan

Action	Owner	Status target
Submit registry and platform corrections.	Legal + Priveris	Tracked by source type.
Harden personal recovery paths.	Client + Priveris	Priority accounts completed.
Create incident route for threat or doxxing.	Family office	Escalation protocol documented.

Prescriber takeaway

The value for a private bank, family office or legal advisor is not a technical scan. It is a qualified decision path: what to reduce, what to monitor, who must approve, and when to escalate.
